Re: Los Angeles/Long Beach Clean Truck Fee

Dear Valued Customer,

The Ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach will begin enforcement of the Clean Air Action Plan (CAAP) as of January 1, 2010. The implementation of this legislation will ban all trucks manufactured before 1993 from entering the port. Trucks manufactured between 1994 and 2003 will only be permitted if they have been retrofitted with a diesel particulate filter.

In order for us to offer uninterrupted service, we are now compelled to pay our trucker a clean truck fee. However, we were able to reduce the rates based on a compromise with our trucking companies.

Effective Friday January 1, 2010, we will charge \$25.00/20' and \$50.00/40' for each container dispatched. You will no longer be paying the Clean Truck Fee (CTF) to the ports.
